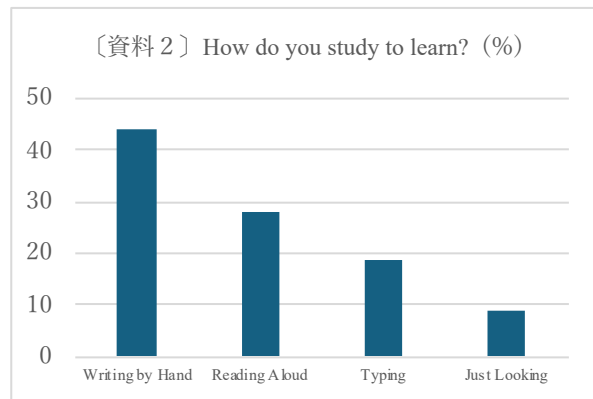

4 英語の授業で、ALT のブラウン(Mr. Brown) 先生がクラスで「学び方」についてプレゼンテーションを行い、そのときに使われた、記憶率 (Memory Recall) に関するグラフと、「How do you study to learn? (どのようにするか)」というアンケートの結果を見て、本文を読み、あとの各問に答えなさい。



Do you remember things better when you write them by hand? Some students say yes, but others say no. These days, many students use computers or smartphones to take notes. But which way really helps your memory? Many teachers and students are interested A the question.

A group of teachers at a junior high school wanted to learn more about this. 200 students joined it. First, all of the students studied a list of 30 English words for 15 minutes. B were four groups of students.

- The first group wrote the words by hand.
- The second group read the words aloud.
- The third group typed the words on a computer.
- The last group just looked at the words on paper.

One hour later, all students took the same test to check their memory. The first graph shows the average test score for each group. Some students wrote the words by hand. These students got the highest scores. Writing by hand helped students remember more than reading aloud, typing, or just looking. Reading aloud also worked well. But just looking at the words helped the least. One teacher explained, “When students write by hand, they use their eyes, hands, and brains at the same time. That makes their memory stronger.”

In another survey, the same school asked students about their favorite method. The result was a little different from the memory scores. This time, students did not only think about memory. They thought about comfort and speed, too. (1) the second graph.

Many students still liked writing by hand the most, but not everyone. Some students thought it was slow and made them tired. One second-year student said, “Typing is faster and easier, and I don’t get tired.” Another said, “Reading aloud helps me focus. I use my voice and ears, and that helps me stay awake.” あ students liked just looking because it was easy, but い students did not remember well with that way.

So, what is the best way to study? It depends on your goal. If you just want to finish your homework quickly, typing may be good. But if you want to remember something for a long time, writing by hand is a better choice. It may take more time and energy, but it helps your brain remember more. Reading aloud can also help, especially for students who enjoy speaking or listening.

(2) Many students say they can remember science facts or history dates better when they write them down. Some students even use a special notebook for difficult subjects. Other students make their own flashcards and write the same word many times. There are many ways to study, but the best methods use both your body and your brain. Next time you need to study for a test, think about what your goal is. Do you want to finish quickly, or do you want to remember it well? quickly, or do you want to remember it well?
